Background of calls

Government College Girls, Patiala is a reputed institution in North India. I feel very happy and proud to say that this institute which got grade on NAAC Arts in 2016 has completed its 5 years journey in 2017 touching the pinnacle of success. On June 20, 1942, its classes began at Victoria Girls' School, Patiala. At that time it was named Victoria Girls College. In 1950, the PEPSU government converted it into a degree college. It was the first girls' degree college of PEPSU Government. After that it was renamed as 'Government College for Women'.

The present building of the college was formally inaugurated by the then Vice President Dr. Sarvapalli Radhakrishnan made it proud by inaugurating it on 23 January 1954. Maharani Mahendra Pal Kaur ji gave glory to this institution by inaugurating it with her lotus flowers on 17 March 1954. During the golden jubilee ceremony held at the college in 1992, the late S. Beant Singh then Chief Minister of Punjab changed the name of this college from Government College for Women to Government College for Girls, Patiala (current name). Since then this college has been imparting good and quality education to the girls of Malwa

region. This college has created a unique identity in the educational field due to its outstanding and unique achievements.

Realizing the motto Satyam, Shivam, Sundaram (Truthful, Welfare, Beautiful) of the college, this institution provides literary, cultural: Academic, NCC, NSS, Activities like Red Cross and sports have been flourishing.

Now I am pleased to present before you the annual report of Government College Girls, Patiala for the year 2018-19.

Admission

Around 2243 girl students took admission in various categories this year. Undergraduate courses in the college include B.A. (Arts), B.Sc. (Home Science), B.Sc. (Biotechnology) and B.Sc. (Medical and Non Medical Computer Applications) are taught. MA in Post Graduate Courses (Dance, Soft Arts and Music Singing) and M.Sc. (Wood and Nutrition) are taught. B.A. Vocational subject Functional English is taught in Arts. Honors in English, Hindi, Psychology, Political Science, Philosophy and Economics subjects are also provided. BCA in HEIS Undergraduate and PGDCA has also been started.

Staff

In the current session there are 35 regular lecturers 01 contractual and 10 part-time lecturers in the college. Apart from this 22 lecturers are teaching as guest faculty and 10 are teaching on contact basis (self finance basis). There is one librarian in the college.
