





#### REPORT

### 1. INSTITUTIONAL VIEWS ON LEARNER CENTRIC EDUCATION

- Concern was raised on the reducing enrolment of students in college. All the members present in the meeting gave their valuable suggestions about increasing the GER.
- It was suggested that there is an urgent need to add new courses so as to make the education multidisciplinary and attract more students.
- Everyone agreed that the B.Com course should be added in the near future on priority.
   Along with this, short term certificate and diploma courses should also be added so that students may attain some skilled knowledge and specialisation for better job opportunities.
- Few courses which may be added are:
  - 1. Baking
  - 2. Hotel Management
  - 3. Journalism
  - 4. Dietetics
  - 5. Human Resource Development
  - 6. Folk Art and Culture
  - 7. Nanny training
- Certificate courses in foreign languages like French or Chinese should be introduced so as to enhance the skill of students for better placements.

- Along with the other proposed post graduate courses, introduction of MA in Punjabi should also be considered, as being a favoured course with graduates it may help in increasing the enrolment.
- It was discussed that since the faculty for all the proposed courses may not be available, faculty can be outsourced.
- It was discussed and found that Academic Bank of Credits will be beneficial for students as it will help in making education more flexible and versatile. This flexibility is the need of the hour as it will bring the students abrest of their global counterparts and help them compete globally.
- Students should be allowed to equip themselves with a course according to their own need and inclination so that they can put their qualification to use to generate better employment opportunities. A student should be allowed to enrol in multiple courses at the same time which may or may not be of the same duration.
- While discussing about the guidelines of NHEQF, it was found that suggestions to be made to University for making the required changes in the curriculum and credit system.

### (2) INSTITUTUIONAL PREPAREDNESS AND VIEWS ON DIGITAL LEARNING

- Teachers to be directed to record digital lectures for students and broadcast them through Youtube or other means.
- Smart classrooms and projectors to be brought to maximum use.

- Suggestion for the same should be made to the Board of Studies to incorporate an internship in the syllabus.

- Connect with the alumni to be improved.
- Some reputed and well placed alumni should be invited on regular basis to interact with the students so as to motivate them.
- Regular alumni meets should be organised.
