College Background

Government College Girls, Patiala is a reputed institute of North India. I feel very happy and proud to inform that this institute which got 'A' grade from national organization NAAC in 2016 has successfully completed its 15 year journey in 2017. It has been completed by touching the buds. On June 20, 1942, its classes began at the Victoria Girls' School, Patiala. At that time it was named Victoria Garaj College. In 1950, PEPSU government converted it into a degree college. This is the first of Pepsu Govtlt was a degree college for girls. After that it was renamed as 'Government College for Women'.

The present building of the college was formally inaugurated by the then Vice President Dr. Sarvapalli Radhakrishnan made it proud by inaugurating it on 23 January 1954. Maharani Mahendra Pal Kaur ji inaugurated this institution on 17 March 1931 with her Kar Kamala. During the golden jubilee ceremony held at the college in 1992, late S. Beant Singh, the Chief Minister of Punjab, changed the name of this college from Government College for Women to Government College for Girls, Patiala (current name). Admission
